In the interest of establishing this irreplaceable natural area as a sanctuary for the animal and plant life which live in and use this open space, and to preserve the ecology of this area, it is the purpose of Friends of Salem Woods, Inc. to form a partnership with any and all interested parties, public or private.

To protect these ecosystems, we will develop a corps of volunteers to care for this unique environment and we will encourage the non-destructive use of this area for the purposes of education and recreation.

These woods and wetlands are unique in all of Salem. They are the only home of much of Salem’s wild fauna and flora. They are a legacy we must pass on to our children. They are places where all can meet in peaceful communion and discover the intrinsic value of nature.

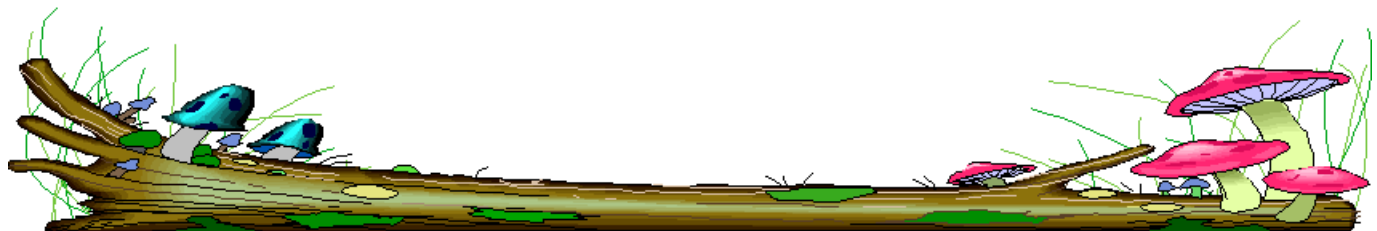
